We are ambitious for our pupils, aiming for high standards in all areas. Attendance is an important part of our success, and we encourage families to work with us to meet our school target of 96% attendance.

- We offer a low cost breakfast club, ensuring every child starts the day with a healthy meal, ready to learn.
- School trips are free of charge, giving every pupil the chance to take part in enriching experiences beyond the classroom.

Early Years & Nursery Provision



We know how important the early years are in laying the foundations for future learning. That's why we offer high-quality, nurturing provision for our youngest learners:

- Spaces for 2-year-olds and Nursery-aged children – both funded and paid places are available.
- A stimulating environment where children can develop independence, curiosity, and confidence.
- 30 hours of free childcare available for eligible families.
- Our early years staff are experienced in supporting young children, helping them feel secure and excited about learning.




Curriculum & Learning

Our school is led by a team of hardworking and caring teachers and support staff, each passionate about education and child development.


We work in close partnership with parents and carers, recognising that strong home-school links are key to success.
